



## 2019 Boston Unity Cup Team Registration & Commitment Letter

Welcome to the 2nd Annual Boston Unity Cup. Adult men's and women's soccer teams from across the City of Boston with cultural origins in nations around the world are invited to compete in this tournament. By signing this letter your team commits to the following:

### FAIR PLAY & SPORTSMANSHIP

Our team understands the spirit of fair play and the good sportsmanship expected by the Boston Unity Cup. We hereby accept responsibility to be a model of good sportsmanship that comes with being an athlete and will refrain from engaging in all types of disrespectful behavior, including inappropriate language, taunting, and unnecessary physical contact. Failure to abide by games rules and display good sportsmanship may result in immediate expulsion from match and tournament.

### UNIFORMS

All jerseys will be supplied by the Boston Unity Cup and must be worn with matching shorts and socks. All players must wear shin guards.

### COMPLETE BRACKET PLAY AND AWARDS CELEBRATION

All teams are guaranteed at least 3 matches in tournament play. All teams **MUST** play ALL matches and any succeeding final matches. All teams to attend the awards and medal celebration, regardless if they are playing in championship.

### ATTEND TEAM ORIENTATION / CAPTAIN'S MEETING

Our team understands they are required to attend Boston Unity Cup Tournament Orientation Meeting on **Wednesday May 1st (time & location to be announced)**. All players are encouraged to attend but at a minimum the Team Representative (Capitan) **MUST attend**. We understand that failure to attend meeting may result in expulsion from tournament.

### TEAM ROSTER

Each team (of adults 18+) may carry a roster of up to 18 players (men or women's team), with minimum 10 players from the country represented. Rosters and player photos are due by **Wednesday May 1, 2019**.

### PENALTIES

Failure to fulfill your team commitments will result in possible suspension from play the following year (to be determined by Unity Cup Committee).
